After looking at various options, searching for an alternative leader, and discussing with other parties it has been decided that the field meeting will still take place.

This meeting will take place as a DIY excursion, using a field guide. and co-ordinated by Eric Johnson (unless any members wish to volunteer their knowledge of that section of coast). Details of the excursion are given in two field guides. The YGS Yorkshire Rocks and Landscape a field guide - Excursion 17 and the GA Guide No 34 - The Yorkshire Coast Itinerary 2.

Meeting at The Abbey Plain Pay and Display Car Park next to the Abbey on the east side of Whitby [NZ902 113] at 09.45 for a prompt 10.00 start.

The section is only accessible two hours before and after **low** tide, which is at 13.47 and involves scrambling along 2km of rocky foreshore. Hard hats are needed for protection against the small fragments that fall from the cliffs. The excursion would finish between 4 and 5 o'clock.
